The 'New' Breakfast Club

Welcome to Breakfast Club.

The good news is we will be continuing to run breakfast Club from Monday 7th September with the full session starting from 7.45am and the second session from 8.15am. In order to comply with Government guidance it is essential that you pre-book using the school booking system, ideally before the beginning of each month or term and, in the case of last minute emergencies, at the very latest 48 hours before; we **will not** be able to offer a 'drop in' service for those who have not booked in advance. Furthermore, please ensure that you have clearly stated which days you wish your child to attend, in addition to paying the required fee. (Booking forms can be found on the school website under menu, School Community, Breakfast Club).

To ensure the safety of the school community, children will have to sanitize their hands on arrival at school and again before they leave Breakfast Club and head to their classrooms (which will be done at staggered intervals). In order to maintain social distancing, and to keep the 'bubbles' apart, there will be separate tables for each Year Group and they must remain seated at these tables at all times. Consequently, a member of staff will take their order for breakfast and this will be served at their table on a tray; at the end of breakfast they will put breakfast items back on their tray and a member of staff will clear it away. Just like being in a restaurant, what fun! Should they need to visit the bathroom then they will be escorted there by a member of staff.

When the play session commences students will be required to remain at their tables where they will have their own box of resources (including pens, pencils and other basic stationery; plain paper for colouring; a booklet with simple origami ideas; a 'how to draw' booklet and some age-related quiz activities; and a Lego box). I strongly recommend that if your child is a keen and confident reader that they bring in a reading book. I will try to continue with some simple craft activities at various times in the year but this is logistically and financially more challenging now we have to have separate resources for each Year Group.

Regrettably, we will be unable to play team games as we have done in the past due to the need to maintain social distancing. However, I have some ideas for some fun games which can be played whilst standing by their tables, which will get the endorphins pulsing and the giggles overflowing.

I strongly believe that it would be helpful if you could share some of these changes with your child beforehand so that they are prepared and it will feel less alien to them. Once the guidelines are eased, we will return to the 'old normal'. Finally, should you be new to Breakfast Club you can find further information on the School website.
